The Chickasaw City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, October 8, 2019 at 7:00 PM with the following members present: Barry Broadhead, Derrick Jones, Jennifer White, and Adam Bourne, James Hanson and Mayor Byron Pittman who presided. Attorney Jay Minus was absent. City Clerk Jessica Veals was also present. Mr. Bourne opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Broadhead made a motion seconded by Mr. Bourne to approve the minutes of the September 24, 2019 regular meeting minutes as previously distributed. Motion carried and so ordered.

CORRESPONDENCE

A resignation was presented for Jason Hadaway, Public Safety Officer. Mr. Hanson made a motion seconded by Mr. Bourne to accept his resignation in “good standing”. Motion carried and so ordered.

Final Quarter Working Test Report was presented for Joseph Lynch, Public Safety Officer, which the Department Head stated that he had concluded that the above named employee should be permitted to acquire permanent status. Mr. White made a motion seconded by Mr. Broadhead to accept the Department Head’s recommendation. Motion carried and so ordered.

Attorney’s Report: Mr. Minus was absent.

Chief’s Report: Chief Fillingim presented the Public Safety Report for September, 2019.

Code Inspector’s Report: Mr. Dennis Sullivan gave the September, 2019 Inspection Report.

COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS

Parks and Recreation: Miss White made a motion seconded by Mr. Hanson to allow the Mayor to sign a contract with Alabama Power for a right-of-way easement. Motion carried and so ordered.

Finance: Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Miss White to authorize the accounts payable in the amount of \$37,429.59 to be placed in line for payment. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Mr. Hanson and Mr. Jones to allow Mayor Pittman to sign a contract to lease the property located at the Chickasaw Armory for the use of a cell

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phone tower, pending attorney approval. Motion carried and so ordered.

Public Service: Mr. Hanson had nothing to vote on.

Maintenance and Sanitation: Mr. Broadhead had nothing to vote on.

Public Safety: Mr. Jones made a motion seconded by Mr. Bourne to approve an application for a neighborhood street party located on the corner of Mauvilla Drive East and Mauvilla Drive South. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor's Report: Mr. Pittman had nothing to vote on.
