The Chickasaw City Council met in regular session, via Zoom video conference call, on Tuesday, September 22, 2020 at 7:00 PM with the following members present: Barry Broadhead, Derrick Jones, Adam Bourne, James Hanson, Jennifer White and Mayor Byron Pittman who presided. City Clerk Jessica Veals and Attorney Jay Minus were also present. A reporter from the Call News was also present. Mr. Bourne opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Broadhead made a motion seconded by Mr. Bourne to approve the minutes of the September 8, 2020 work session meeting minutes as previously distributed. Motion carried and so ordered.

Attorney's Report: Mr. Minus had nothing to present.

Parks and Recreation: Miss White had nothing to vote on.

Finance: Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Mr. Hanson to place the accounts payable in the amount of \$24,319.89 in line for payment. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Mr. Hanson to authorize the Chief to purchase the Life Pack 15, that includes a chest compression machine for our Fire Department. Due to COVID-19, the city can apply for reimbursement for the machine through the Cares Act. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Miss White and Mr. Hanson to authorize the Chief to purchase a new police vehicle in the amount of \$32,295.00. The city will receive \$10,000.00 towards the new police vehicle from AMIC for a previously wrecked police vehicle. Motion carried and so ordered.

Public Service: Mr. Hanson had nothing to vote on.

Maintenance and Sanitation: Mr. Broadhead made a motion seconded by Mr. Jones and Miss White to authorize the Recreation Director to purchase new auditorium curtains from Showbiz Theatrical Services, Inc. in the amount of \$12,051.00. Motion carried and so ordered.

Public Safety: Mr. Jones had nothing to vote on.
