The Chickasaw City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, June 08, 2021 at 7:00 PM with the following members present: Jason Rawls, Ken Sterrett, James Hanson, Jennifer White, Adam Bourne and Mayor Barry Broadhead who presided. City Clerk Jessica Veals and City Attorney Nash Campbell were also present. Mr. Bourne opened the meeting with prayer.

**ADOPTION OF AGENDA**

Miss White made a motion seconded by Mr. Hanson to approve the agenda for the regular scheduled council meeting on June 08, 2021. Motion carried and so ordered.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Mr. Sterrett to approve the minutes of the May 25, 2021 regular scheduled meeting minutes as previously distributed. Motion carried and so ordered.

**COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE MAYOR**

Mayor Broadhead stated that the Animal Control Ordinance would be open for discussion and public comment during a council committee report on June 10, 2021 at 6:00 PM in the courtroom. Miss White made a motion seconded by Mr. Rawls to set a council committee meeting to discuss possible changes and additions to the Animal Control Ordinance. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor Broadhead presented the annual contract with Neel-Schaffer, Inc. to the council, and requested their approval to authorize him to sign. Miss White made a motion seconded by Mr. Bourne to authorize Mayor Broadhead to sign the annual contract with Neel-Schaffer. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor Broadhead presented a quote in the amount of \$2,002.28 from Ladsco for repairs to the municipal court offices. Mr. Hanson made a motion seconded by Mr. Bourne to approve the repairs to the municipal court offices. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor Broadhead presented a quote in the amount of \$2,884.00 for Mobile Fencing to replace the fence at the pump house. The fence was damaged during the hurricanes last year. Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Mr. Rawls to approve the pump house fence to be replaced. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor Broadhead announced that a decision was made regarding the new city garbage contract. Mr. Hanson made a motion seconded by Mr. Bourne to award the new city garbage contract to A-1 McDuffie Sanitation. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor Broadhead presented a quote to lease a new city garbage truck from National Auto Fleet Group, in the amount of \$167,442.00. The mayor was presented with three quotes, and this quote fit the city's needs best overall. Mr. Bourne made a motion seconded by Miss White to approve the city entering into a lease with National Auto Fleet Group, pending city attorney review. Motion carried and so ordered.
