

## RESOLUTION 25-50

### *A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A TRANSPORTATION PLAN PURSUANT TO THE REBUILD ALABAMA ACT 2019-2 FOR THE CITY OF CHICKASAW FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025*

WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature in Act 2019-2 adopted the Rebuild Alabama Act to levy an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel, and

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Alabama Act provides for an allocation amount to the municipalities of the state based on the ratio of populations of each municipality to the total populations of all municipalities of the state, a portion of the additional taxes levied under the Act to be used for transportation infrastructure, improvements, preservation, and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chickasaw pledges to keep this money in a separate fund and expend only for maintenance, improvement, replacement, and construction of road or bridge projects as mandated by the Act, and

WHEREAS, the City of Chickasaw is to adopt an annual transportation plan no later than August 31 for the next fiscal year, based on an estimate of revenues

#### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

1. The City of Chickasaw hereby adopts this Resolution as its Transportation Plan submitted in compliance with the Rebuild Act, Act No. 2019-2
2. Pursuant to the 2019-2 Act, the State of Alabama estimated the City of Chickasaw to receive an anticipated allocation from the Rebuild Alabama Act fund for the fiscal year (FY24-25) of \$64,168.00, with increasing allocations for each fiscal year thereafter. As of August 13, 2025, the total amount received from The Rebuild Alabama Fund is \$256,405.48. The amount received has been placed in a separate fund account to accumulate in order to assist with funding of roadway improvements, repairs, resurfacing, reconstruction, and qualified roadway projects in the future.
3. Pursuant to the Act, the City anticipates expending funds received in part or in whole to fund any of the following projects listed below hereto and incorporated by reference.




