WORK SESSION –

- Franchise Agreement with Local Gov.. The Maximum amount of fees to be charged is \$20,000.00. Councilmember White asked when negotiating with Unity Fiber: Please ask them to reserve dark fiber (at least two strands) for the City of Chickasaw.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHICKASAW THROUGH THE COUNCIL TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OF SAID CITY TO EXECUTE A RIGHT-OF-WAY FRANCHISE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY SERVICE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Chickasaw desires to regulate and oversee the provision of cable television, broadband, telecommunication, gas, and water services within the City's rights-of-way;

WHEREAS, Local Government Services, LLC has available a right-of-way franchise management advisory service to assist the City in such regulation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Chickasaw is hereby authorized to execute a right-of-way franchise management advisory service agreement on behalf of the City, in substantially the same form as Appendix A, which is attached to and made a part of this resolution.
