Motion was made by Councilmember Couey, seconded by Councilmember White, to approve the Digital Advertising Rates and Sample Advertising Policy. Motion carried.

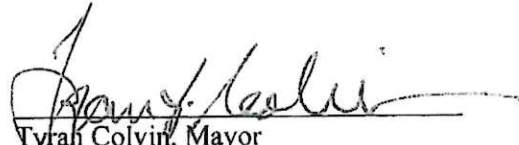
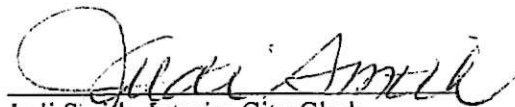
